Please complete this application form to become a Full Member of the JLR RAC Old Boys' Association. Membership is valid until 28 February each year. The initial fee is just £10. The annual subscription fee on renewal is only £6.50. Online applications can be made at www.jlrrac.co.uk/memberapp.php

FULL MEMBERSHIP of the Association is open to all who enlisted as a boy soldier /bandsman before attaining the age of 17½ and served in the Boys' Squadron or Junior Leaders' Regiment, Royal Armoured Corps.

FULL MEMBERSHIP of the Association is also open to all who have served as servicemen/women at the Boys' Squadron and Junior Leaders' Regiment, Royal Armoured Corps as Permanent Staff.

FULL MEMBERSHIP of the Association is also open to all who have served as civilian instructors at the Boys' Squadron and Junior Leaders' Regiment, Royal Armoured Corps as Permanent Staff.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP is open to spouses and partners of Full Members. Widows, whose late husband/partner fitted the criteria for Full Membership can also apply for Associated membership. Spouses/partners and widows are exempt from paying the Annual Subscription.

Members of the previous Old Boys' Association founded in October 1959 will be exempt any joining fee. Members of the previous Old Boys' Association who subscribed to a 'life membership' will be exempt annual subscriptions. Evidence will be required of membership of the former Old Boys' Association.
